 - Boys' Varsity Tennis beat Norwayne 5-0. The team is now 2-4 on the season.

- Varsity Baseball beat Mansfield Senior 20-2. The Knights jumped out early in the first and then had a huge inning in the third with 11 runs scored. Bridger Cline threw 3 innings striking out 8 and walking 1. Grant Miller went in for relief for 2 innings pitched, 4 strikeouts, 2 walks, and 2 earned.

- JV Baseball defeated Mansfield Senior 21-0. The Knights continued their perfect season with a 21-0 win over the Tygers on Wednesday night. Leading the offense with four hits was Mark Biltz (2 doubles, 2 RBI, and 4 runs scored). Phillip Lepley added 3 hits (2 RBI) with Caleb Martin (5 RBI), Gavin Christine, and Nick Morris having two hits apiece. Others having a hit were Zach Stair, Vaughn Ervin, Michael Miller, Peyton McKinney, and John Hughes. Christine got the win on the mound throwing 1 hit ball over 3 innings while striking out 7 Tygers. Martin and Ginsberg each pitched an inning while striking out the side. The Knights are now 6-0, 2-0 in OCC play, and host Loudonville and Triway on Saturday.

- Varsity Softball beat Mansfield Senior 16-0. Lexi Martin was 4-4 with 3 RBIs, Maddie Woods was 3-4 with a HR and 3 RBIs, Jessica Yabroff was 2-4 with a 2B and 2RBI, and Jessie Keen was 2-3 with an RBI. Morganne Balder gathered her first hit of the year as well. Olivia Ferguson picked up the 1 hit shutout for her first win of the season. The team is now 8-2 overall and 4-0 OCC. The team plays Hiland tonight.
